


### Paper Plate Flowers

April showers bring May flowers! This flower craft combines an important skill with a fun craft. Kids get scissor practice making the petals for these brightly colored flowers. Scissor practice helps strengthen fine motor skills needed for proper pencil grip and handwriting.

- Here's what you'll need:
- Small paper plates (dessert size)
  - Paint (green paint & other desired colors)
  - Craft Stick
  - Green Paper (foam paper is best)
  - Scissors
  - Glue

1. Cut small slits into the parameter of paper plates. Go back through and cut another slit so that the slits connect and you cut out a small piece. Preschoolers might need help with the second slit. This makes your flower petals.
2. Paint craft stick green and paint paper plate desired colors and allow both to dry.
3. Glue craft stick to the back of the paper plate as the stem and cut two leaves from the green paper and glue to either side of the craft stick.
